REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE
MINISTER OF TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF THE MOTOR
VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (CUNUPIA/
ST. JOSEPH/MT. LAMBERT/EL DORADO/TACARIGUA/
TUNAPUNA/CHAGUANAS/ENDEAVOUR/PORT-OF-SPAIN/
EL SOCORRO/ARIMA) REGULATIONS, 2011

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (Cunupia/St. Joseph/Mt. Lambert/
El Dorado/Tacarigua/Tunapuna/Chaguanas/Endeavour/Port-of-Spain/
El Socorro/Arima) Regulations, 2011.

2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday 5th December, Duration
2011 to Monday 5th March, 2012.

PART I

CUNUPIA

3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not enter the northbound No entry
lane of Uriah Butler Highway from the Warren Branch at the
Warrenville walkover, Monday to Friday from 6.30 a.m. to 8.30 a.m.,
except on public holidays.

PART II

ST. JOSEPH

4. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from— No right turn

- (a) Eastern Main Road, onto Agostini Street, Monday to Friday
from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m., except on public holidays; and
- (b) Hutton Street, onto the Eastern Main Road, Monday to
Friday from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m., except on public
holidays.

5. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a— One-way traffic

- (a) southerly direction on Agostini Street, Monday to Friday
from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m., except on public holidays; and
- (b) northerly direction on Agostini Street, Monday to Friday
from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., except on public holidays.

Taxi stand 6. A maximum of ten taxis plying the Maracas/St. Joseph route shall park facing west on Eastern Main Road along the Curepe Priority Mall.

Parking prohibited 7. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on Farm Road.

PART III

MT. LAMBERT

No right turn 8. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from Busby Street onto Eastern Main Road from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

No left turn 9. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn left onto Eastern Main Road from Busby Street from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

PART IV

EL DORADO

No right turn 10. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from Jordan Street onto Eastern Main Road from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

PART V

TACARIGUA

Stopping and waiting prohibited 11. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not stop and wait on the northern and southern sides of the Eastern Main Road, between Andrea Street and Ojoe Road roundabout.

One-way traffic 12. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in—
(a) a northerly direction on Richard Street, from Back Street to Eastern Main Road from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays;
(b) a northerly direction on Beccles Street, from Back Street to Eastern Main Road from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays;
(c) an easterly direction on Peters Road, from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays;
(d) an easterly direction on Bali Street from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays; and
(e) an easterly direction on Back Street, between Richard Street and Thavenot Street from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

13. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from Thavenot Street onto Eastern Main Road from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays. No right turn

PART VI

TUNAPUNA

14. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on— Parking prohibited
- (a) Auzonville Road from Monday to Saturday, except on public holidays;
 - (b) Cochrane Street from Monday to Saturday, except on public holidays;
 - (c) the eastern side of Morton Street on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, except on public holidays;
 - (d) the western side of Morton Street on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, except on public holidays;
 - (e) Sapodilla Street from Monday to Saturday, except on public holidays; and
 - (f) the western side of Park Lane from Monday to Saturday, except on public holidays.

15. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a southerly direction on Tunapuna Road, from Francis Street to Eastern Main Road, from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays. One-way traffic

PART VII

CHAGUANAS

16. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn left onto Southern Main Road from— No left turn

- (a) Gaston Street; and
- (b) Smith Street.

17. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a— One-way traffic
- (a) westerly direction on Southern Main Road, between La Clave Street and de Verteuil Street;
 - (b) northerly direction on Gaston Street, between Southern Main Road and John Street;
 - (c) southerly direction on Henry Street, between Southern Main Road and John Street; and
 - (d) northerly direction on Smith Street, between Southern Main Road and John Street.

730 *Traffic Control (Experimental Scheme) (Cunupia / St. Joseph / Mt. Lambert / El Dorado / Tacarigua / Tunapuna / Chaguanas / Endeavour / Port-of-Spain / El Socorro / Arima) Regulations, 2011*

- No right turn 18. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from—
(a) Constance Street onto Southern Main Road;
(b) Hugh Street onto Southern Main Road;
(c) Chaguanas Main Road onto the Uriah Butler Highway northbound entrance ramp; and
(d) Uriah Butler Highway northbound exit ramp onto the Chaguanas Main Road.
- No entry 19. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not enter Trail Street from Marc Street.
- Parking prohibited 20. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on—
(a) Trail Street;
(b) Marc Street; and
(c) Yard Street.

PART VIII

ENDEAVOUR

- One-way traffic 21. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in—
(a) a southerly direction on Mulchan Seuchan Road, between 2nd Avenue and Endeavour Road;
(b) an easterly direction on Endeavour Road, between Caroni Savannah Road and Chan Ramlal Road; and
(c) a northerly direction on Xavier Street, between 2nd Avenue and Endeavour Road.
- No right turn 22. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from Chan Ramlal Road onto Endeavour Road.
- No entry 23. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not enter—
(a) Endeavour Road from Mulchan Seuchan Road;
(b) Mulchan Seuchan Road after 2nd Avenue, heading north; and
(c) Endeavour Road after Chan Ramlal Road, heading west.
- Parking prohibited 24. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on 2nd Avenue.

PART IX

PORT-OF-SPAIN

- No left turn 25. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn left onto Edward Street, from Independence Square South.

26. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a— One-way traffic
- (a) southerly direction on Murray Street, between Ariapita Avenue and the southern end of Adam Smith Square;
 - (b) westerly direction along the southern end of Adam Smith Square, between Murray Street and Carlos Street; and
 - (c) northerly direction on Edward Street, between Wrightson Road and Independence Square South.

27. (1) A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right onto— No right turn
- (a) Sackville Street, from the westbound lane of Wrightson Road;
 - (b) Edward Street, from the westbound lane of Wrightson Road;
 - (c) Tragarete Road, from Gatacre Street; and
 - (d) Colville Street, from Ariapita Avenue,

between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

(2) A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right onto Tragarete Road from Woodford Street from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

28. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not make a “U” turn onto— No “U” turn

- (a) the eastbound lane of Wrightson Road at its intersection with Sackville Street, from the westbound lane of Wrightson Road; and
- (b) the eastbound lane of Wrightson Road at its intersection with Edward Street, from the westbound lane of Wrightson Road,

between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

29. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on Belle Smythe Street. Parking prohibited

30. A person driving a motor vehicle on roadways with opposite lanes of traffic shall not park, wait or stop his motor vehicle facing the opposite direction as the flow of traffic for that side of the roadway. Parking, waiting or stopping in a specified direction prohibited

PART X
EL SOCORRO

31. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in— One-way traffic
- (a) an easterly direction on Evelyn Trace, between El Socorro Road and Boundary Road;

- (b) a westerly direction on Ward Lane, between El Socorro Road and Don Miguel Road;
- (c) a westerly direction on Farouk Avenue, between El Socorro Road and William Street; and
- (d) an easterly direction on Fazal Avenue, between El Socorro Road and William Street.

All-way stop 32. A person driving a motor vehicle approaching the junction of Sixth Avenue and George Bailey Drive shall stop before proceeding onward.

Loading or off-loading restricted 33. A person shall not load or off-load a goods vehicle on—
(a) El Socorro Road; and
(b) Aranguez Main Road,
between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays.

PART XI
ARIMA

Parking prohibited 34. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on Queen Street, between Sorzano Street and de Verteuil Street.

PART XII
GENERAL

Offence and penalty 35. (1) Subject to subsection (2), a person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars.

(2) A person who is found guilty of subsequent contravention of any of the provisions of these Regulations is liable on summary conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 36. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
