AN ORDINANCE to amend the Moneylenders
Ordinance, Ch. 31. No. 11.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Moneylenders (Amendment) Ordinance, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Moneylenders Ordinance. Short title.

2. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 3 and subsection (1) of section 9 of the Moneylenders Ordinance are hereby respectively amended by substituting the words "Commissioner of Inland Revenue" for the word "Treasurer" appearing therein.
