AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE, 1950

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Trinidad Stock Feeds Limited) (Stock and Poultry Feeds) Order, 1950.

2. Trinidad Stock Feeds Limited, a company registered under the Companies Ordinance, is hereby declared to be a pioneer manufacturer for the purposes of the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance, 1950 in relation to its pioneer factory situate at Curepe, St. Joseph, Trinidad, and to the manufacture in the Colony on a factory scale of balanced stock and poultry feeds and the preparation in the Colony of ingredients for such feeds (by the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Stock and Poultry Feeds) Order, 1950 declared to be a pioneer industry for the purposes of the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance, 1950), with effect from the 15th September, 1949, and the production day of the said company in relation to the products declared to be pioneer products by the said Order is hereby declared to be the 1st August, 1948.
