AN ORDINANCE to amend the Motor Vehicles Insurance
(Third-party Risks) Ordinance, 1933.

[8th August, 1940.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles Short title.
Insurance (Third-party Risks) (Amendment) Ordinance,
1940, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles
Insurance (Third-party Risks) Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter
referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 3 of

2. Sub-section (5) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following—

(5) This Ordinance shall not extend to tram-cars or public service motor or trolley vehicles which the Municipal Authorities of Port-of-Spain, San Fernando and Arima, and the Trinidad Electricity Board are authorised by Ordinance to maintain and operate.
