RESOLUTION

DECLARATION OF PENSIONABLE OFFICES OF THE
PORT-OF-SPAIN CORPORATION

It is notified for general information that the following Resolution was passed at a Sitting of the Legislative Council held on the 21st May, 1954:—

Resolved :

That this Council approves in accordance with, and for the purposes of, the provisions of the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 13, the Resolution in the Appendix hereto set forth passed by the Port-of-Spain City Council on the 4th day of March, 1954.

APPENDIX

Whereas since the declaring of the pensionable offices of the Corporation by Resolution of the Port-of-Spain City Council on the 30th May, 1940, which Resolution was approved by the Legislative Council on the 13th December, 1940, and published in the *Royal Gazette* on the 27th December, 1940, many of the grades of the offices have changed in name, some of the offices have been regraded to special grades and certain new offices have been created and provided for in the annual estimates of the Corporation; and

Whereas it is necessary that all these changes on the pensionable staff of the Corporation should be brought in conformity with the provisions of the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 13.
