THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION (PENSIONS) ACT, CHAP. 25:05

RESOLUTIONS

PENSIONABLE OFFICES—COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
ARIMA

WHEREAS section 3 of the Municipal Corporation (Pensions) Act, Chap. 25:05, provides *inter alia* that the Council of a Corporation may by resolution declare a permanent office in the service of the Corporation for which separate provision is made in the annual estimates to be a pensionable office and, that any such resolution shall be approved by resolution of the Senate and the House of Representatives:

And whereas the Council of the Borough of Arima by Resolutions A, B and C dated 29th May, 1985, declared the offices listed in the Schedules being permanent offices in the service of the Borough of Arima for which separate provision is made in the annual estimates of that Borough to be pensionable offices from the dates specified therein:
