THE FOOD AND DRUGS ORDINANCE, 1960

ADDITION OF DRUGS TO THE THIRD SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph 9, Division 1 of the Second Schedule of the Food and Drugs Regulations, as amended, I, FRANCIS CASIMIR PREVATT, Minister of Health, do hereby, on the recommendation of the Drug Advisory Committee, add the following Drugs to the Third Schedule of the Food and Drugs Ordinance, 1960, as experience of their use has revealed that they may be a danger to the health of the public, if their use without medical advice is allowed to continue:—

All drugs containing more than 0.75 per cent by weight of Hexachlorophane (Synonyms:—Hexachlorophene, di-(3, 5, 6—Trichloro—2 Hydroxyphenyl)—Methane).

GRANT OF A LICENCE FOR PETROLEUM OPERATIONS
(Section 37(2))

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for public information that on the 19th day of May, 1972, the Minister of Petroleum and Mines granted Amoco Trinidad Oil Company forty-eight (48) Exploration and Production (Public Petroleum Rights) Licences to carry on exploration and production operations in the Submarine Area off the East Coast of Trinidad, pursuant to an Exploration Licence dated 17th day of July, 1970, and registered as No. 9052/1970.

The location of the forty-eight (48) Licensed Areas, comprising together approximately 262,685.65 acres is shown on the attached map.
