REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HEALTH UNDER SECTION 105
OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (CHOLERA) REGULATIONS, 1992

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Cholera) Citation Regulations, 1992.

2. In these Regulations,—

“sell” includes offer for sale;

“shellfish” means oysters, clams, mussels, scallops and other bivalve molluscs.

3. No person shall, for the duration of six months, harvest, import, buy or sell shellfish without the permission of the Minister under regulation 4.

Prohibition
on shellfish

4. A person may apply in writing to the Minister for permission to harvest, import, buy or sell shellfish on the grounds that the harvesting, importation, purchase or sale is necessary or expedient for scientific purposes and the Minister may grant such permission subject to such terms and conditions as he thinks fit.

5. A person who contravenes regulation 3 or breaches a term or condition of any permission granted under regulation 4 commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of four thousand dollars and imprisonment for six months.
