ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 44F(1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (FATIMA DEVOTIONS) (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) ORDER, 1973

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Fatima Devotions) Citation (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1973.
2. This Order shall come into operation at 3.00 p.m. and shall cease at 6.30 p.m. on Sunday, 13th May, 1973. Commencement and cessation
3. Vehicular traffic will proceed on the undermentioned streets as indicated hereunder:— Vehicular traffic
 - (a) Laventille Road between Piccadilly Street and Picton Road in an easterly direction only;
 - (b) Picton Road between Laventille Road and Eastern Main Road in a southerly direction only.
4. Parking will be prohibited on Laventille Road, between Piccadilly Street and Picton Road. Prohibition of parking
5. Parking will be permitted on Picton Road as directed by the Police on duty. Parking duty
6. From 3.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. Laventille Road between Piccadilly Street and Picton Road will be closed to vehicular traffic. Street closed to traffic
7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order shall be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 78B and 78C of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance. Removal and impounding of unlawfully parked vehicles.
