THE PENSIONS ORDINANCE, CH. 9. No. 6

ORDER

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 12A OF THE
PENSIONS ORDINANCE

THE PENSIONS (APPROVED POST) ORDER, 1976

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 12A of the Pensions Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance") that an officer holding a pensionable office in the public service who, by reason only of his being appointed to an approved post, leaves that service in circumstances other than as are provided for in section 12(1) of the Ordinance may be granted a pension, gratuity or other allowance by the President in respect of his public service:

And whereas subsection (2) of the said section 12A defines "approved post" to mean a post not in the public service, approved for the purposes of subsection (1), by the President by Order published in the *Gazette*:

And whereas the post of Manager of the National Commercial Bank of Trinidad and Tobago is not a post in the public service:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the President by subsection (2) of the said section 12A the following Order is made—
