THE PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE (COMPENSATION FOR LOSS
OF OFFICE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1971

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Transport Service Citation
(Compensation for Loss of Office) (Amendment) Regulations, 1971.
