AN ACT to amend the Pilotage Act, Chap. 51:02

*[Assented to 15th March, 1985]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Pilotage (Amend- Short title  
ment) Act, 1985.

**2. Section 4 of the Pilotage Act is amended—**

(a) in subsection (1) by—

(i) deleting the words “two members” appearing at the beginning of paragraph (c) and substituting therefor the words “one member”;

(ii) deleting the word “and” appearing at the end of paragraph (c);

(iii) repealing paragraph (d) and replacing it as follows—

“(d) a representative of the Port Authority”;

(iv) adding immediately after paragraph (d) the following new paragraphs—

(e) a person who holds a certificate as Master Home Trade, issued by the Government of Trinidad and Tobago, or an equivalent or higher certificate or alternatively someone who has attained the rank of Lieutenant-Commander in the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force;

(f) a Barrister or Solicitor; and

(g) a person suitably qualified in economics, accountancy or commerce;

(b) in subsection (3), by deleting the word “two” appearing in the second line thereof and by substituting therefor the word “four”.
