## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 3 of the Pilotage Ordinance, Ch. 18. No. 3, that the Governor-General may by proclamation amend, vary, or add to the Schedules to the said Ordinance, or revoke any part thereof:

And whereas it is expedient to amend the Second Schedule to the said Ordinance which relates to compulsory pilotage areas:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, do hereby amend the said Second Schedule to the said Ordinance by substituting for paragraphs (b), (e) and (g) thereof the following paragraphs:

- “(b) An area within a radius of  $1\frac{3}{4}$  sea miles from La Carrier Light Beacon in Latitude  $10^{\circ} 19' 19''$  North and Longitude  $61^{\circ} 27' 37''$  West;
- (e) An area within half a sea mile of the jetty known as Point Fortin Jetty, the base of which is on the North Shore of Point Fortin and the seaward end is marked by a light beacon in Latitude  $10^{\circ} 12' 27''$  North and Longitude  $61^{\circ} 42' 07''$  West.
- (g) That part of Lisas Bay also known as Goodridge Bay in the Gulf of Paria bounded as follows:
- (i) on the South and Southwest by an arc having a radius of  $2\frac{1}{4}$  sea miles from Savonetta Point red light in Latitude  $10^{\circ} 24' 07''$  North and Longitude  $61^{\circ} 24' 42''$  West;
  - (ii) on the North by a line drawn due West  $2\frac{1}{4}$  sea miles from the said Savonetta Point red light;
  - (iii) on the East by the shore line”.

- (i) on the South and Southwest by an arc having a radius of  $2\frac{1}{4}$  sea miles from Savonetta Point red light in Latitude  $10^{\circ} 24' 07''$  North and Longitude  $61^{\circ} 24' 42''$  West;
  - (ii) on the North by a line drawn due West  $2\frac{1}{4}$  sea miles from the said Savonetta Point red light;
  - (iii) on the East by the shore line”.
