

GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 31

TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 22 OF THE PORT SERVICES (DUES, CHARGES AND MANAGEMENT) ORDINANCE, 1948

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Management of Harbours and Wharves (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Management of Harbours and Wharves Bye-laws, 1948, which are contained in Schedule IV to the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) Ordinance, 1948, and which Bye-laws together with such amendments thereof as have been made from time to time and are still in force are hereinafter referred to as the Principal Bye-laws.

2. The charges specified in the items of the tariff contained in Schedule "C" to the Principal Bye-laws which are set out in the first column of the Schedule to these Bye-laws shall be subject to the percentage increases set out in the second column of the said Schedule hereto in lieu of the percentage increases set out in the second column of the Schedule to the Management of Harbours and Wharves (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1951.

3. Item 7 of Schedule "C" to the Principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by adding thereto at the end of the paragraph thereof headed "Minimum Overtime Charges" the following sub-paragraph:—

"Where men who have not worked during a day are called upon to commence work at 6 p.m. on such day, they shall be paid for a minimum period of 4 hours at the appropriate overtime rates."
