

And Whereas the Governor in Council is satisfied that the said Company carries on the same classes of assurance business in the United Kingdom and that the Company has complied in relation thereto with the provisions of the Law of the United Kingdom with respect to deposits and guarantees by, and minimum paid up share capital and margin of solvency of, assurance companies from time to time in force and applicable to the said Company:

Now, therefore, the Governor in Council in the exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 37 of the Assurance Companies Ordinance hereby orders and declares as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Assurance Companies (Excess Insurance Company Limited) Order, 1956.

2. The provisions of section 37 of the said Ordinance shall apply to the said Excess Insurance Company Limited.

BYE-LAWS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 22 OF THE  
PORT SERVICES (DUES, CHARGES AND MANAGEMENT) ORDINANCE

THE MANAGEMENT OF HARBOURS AND WHARVES  
(AMENDMENT) BYE-LAWS, 1956

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Management of Harbours and Wharves (Amendment) (No. 2) Bye-laws, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Management of Harbours and Wharves Bye-laws which are contained in Schedule IV to the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) Ordinance, which Bye-laws, as amended, are hereinafter referred to as the Principal Bye-laws.

2. The charges set forth in the Tariff contained in Schedule "C" to the Principal Bye-laws shall in respect of each of the services specified in the undermentioned items thereof be increased as follows:—

(a) in respect of items 1 to 7, inclusive, and item 19, by 8 per centum;

and

(b) in respect of items 12, 13 and 14, by 4 per centum.
