THE SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT (MAYARO AND MANZANILLA BEACHES) ORDER, 1960

2. A special speed limit of 15 miles an hour is hereby imposed with respect to Mayaro Beach in the County of Mayaro and Manzanilla Beach in the Counties of St. Andrew and St. David.

MADE BY THE TRANSPORT BOARD UNDER SECTION 44C OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS ENACTED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1956.

THE MISCELLANEOUS STREETS (NO PARKING) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1960

1. This Order may be cited as the Miscellaneous Streets (No Parking) (Amendment) Order, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Miscellaneous Streets (No Parking) Order, 1960 (Government Notice No. 79 of 1960) in this Order referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by adding immediately after item (5) thereof the following:—

“(6) That portion of Queen Street in the City of Port-of-Spain which lies between Frederick Street and Chacon Street.”

THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE, CH. 33. No. 3

ORDER

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 3 (1) OF THE
AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE

THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES (MANUFACTURE OF
COMPLETE FERTILIZERS) ORDER, 1960

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture of Complete Fertilizers) Order, 1960.

2. In this Order "complete fertilizers" means fertilizers containing nitrogen, phosphorous and potassium.

3. The manufacture of complete fertilizers on a commercial scale is hereby declared to be a pioneer industry and complete fertilizers are hereby declared to be the pioneer products of that industry.

ORDINANCE, CH. 18. No. 2

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 22 OF THE PORT SERVICES
(DUES, CHARGES AND MANAGEMENT) ORDINANCE

THE MANAGEMENT OF HARBOURS AND WHARVES (AMENDMENT)
BYE-LAWS, 1960

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Management of Harbours and Wharves (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Management of Harbours and Wharves Bye-Laws which are contained in Schedule IV to the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) Ordinance, which Bye-Laws, as amended, are hereinafter referred to as the Principal Bye-Laws.

2. The charges set forth in the Tariff contained in Schedule "C" to the Principal Bye-Laws as increased by the Management of Harbours and Wharves (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 1959, shall in respect of each of the services specified in the undermentioned item thereof be further increased as follows:—

- (a) in respect of items 1 to 7, inclusive, and item 19 by 16 per centum;
- (b) in respect of item 8, by 6 per centum;
- (c) in respect of items 13 and 14, by 5 per centum.
