TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 22 OF THE PORT SERVICES (DUES, CHARGES AND MANAGEMENT) ORDINANCE, 1948

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Management of Slipways (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Management of Slipways Bye-laws, 1948, which are contained in Schedule VI to the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) Ordinance, 1948, and which Bye-laws together with such amendments thereof as have been made from time to time and are still in force are hereinafter referred to as the Principal Bye-laws.

2. The charges specified in the items of the tariff contained in Appendix "A" to the Principal Bye-laws which are set out in the first column of the Schedule to these Bye-laws shall be subject to the percentage increases set out in the second column of the said Schedule hereto in lieu of the percentage increases set out in the second column of the Schedule to the Management of Slipways (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1951.

AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 3 (1) OF THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE, 1950

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Processing and refining of crude ores) Order, 1953.

2. The processing and refining of crude ores is hereby declared to be a pioneer industry for the purposes of the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance, 1950, and processed and refined crude ores (and in particular Barytes) are hereby declared to be pioneer products for the said purposes.
