THE ORISA MARRIAGE (RECOGNISED ORISA ORGANISATION)
(PRESCRIBED CRITERIA) REGULATIONS, 2000

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Orisa Marriage Citation
(Recognised Orisa Organisation) (Prescribed Criteria) Regulations, 2000.

2. In these Regulations, “Act” means the Orisa Marriage Act, 1999. Interpretation
Act No. 22 of
1999

3. The criteria set out in the Schedule shall be the criteria for the Criteria
designation of an Orisa organisation as a Recognised Orisa
Organisation pursuant to section 6(3) of the Act.

SCHEDULE

(Regulation 3)

CRITERIA FOR DESIGNATION AS A RECOGNISED
ORISA ORGANISATION

1. Orisa organisations incorporated by statute are designated as Recognised Orisa organisations.

2. An application by an Orisa organisation not incorporated by statute, for designation as a Recognised Orisa Organisation, shall be in writing and shall be signed by the Head and Vice Head of the Organisation and at least two elders.

3. An Orisa organisation referred to in paragraph 2 shall comprise at least twenty-five members on the date of application.
