*Old Metal and Marine Stores (Amendment).*

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Old Metal and Marine Stores Ordinance, Ch. 30. No. 7.

[31st December, 1942.]

Commencement.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Old Metal and Marine Stores (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, and shall be read and construed as one with the Old Metal and Marine Stores Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title, etc.

Ch. 30. No. 7.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting subsection (2) thereof and substituting therefor the following subsection—

Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance amended.

“(2) No such licence shall be granted without the previous report of the officer of Police in charge of the division in which the premises to be licensed are situate, and before the expiration of twenty-one days at least after application in writing has been made therefor to the Magistrate.”

3. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words “officer of Police in charge of the division in which the licensee carries on his business” for the words “Commissioner of Police” where they occur therein.
