A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (3) of section 13 of the Provident Fund Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 9, that the Governor in Council may with the approval of the Secretary of State amend the First Schedule to the said Ordinance from time to time by proclamation adding the name of any depositor who he is satisfied has inadvertently omitted to exercise the option provided for by section 18 within the period prescribed by the said section:

And whereas it is enacted by section 3 of the Public Service Commission Ordinance that wherever in any law for the time being in force there is any provision affecting or relating to the appointment, promotion or transfer, or the dismissal or other disciplinary control, of any public officer, or to any other matter which in the opinion of the Governor affects the public service, and any reference is made in such provision to the Executive Council of the Colony, such reference shall be construed as a reference to the Public Service Commission established under the authority of section 64 of the Trinidad and Tobago (Constitution) Order in Council, 1950, and the expression "Governor in Council" or "Governor in Executive Council" or any other similar expression implying action by the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council of the Colony shall, wherever used in any such provision, mean the Governor acting with the advice of such Public Service Commission, but not necessarily in accordance with such advice:

Now, therefore, I, EDWARD BETHAM BEETHAM, Governor as aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Public Service Commission and with the approval of the Secretary of State do hereby amend the First Schedule to the Provident

Fund Ordinance, by adding thereto the name of the officer set out in the Schedule hereto:—

CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, CH. 32. No. 2

ORDER

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE
CUSTOMS ORDINANCE

THE CUSTOMS (IMPORT DUTY) ORDER, 1956

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Import Duty) Order, 1956, and shall come into operation on the date of publication hereof in the *Royal Gazette*.

2. The import duties of customs immediately before the commencement of this Order imposed on each article set out in item 9, in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (j) of item 88, and in item 101 of the First Schedule of the Schedules of Import Duties and Exemptions from Duties imposed under the Customs Ordinance are hereby increased by an amount equal to five per centum of the value of such article.
