A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 2 of the Provident Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950 (No. 2 of 1950), that the Governor in Council may with the approval of the Secretary of State amend the Schedule to the said Ordinance from time to time by Proclamation adding thereto the name of any depositor who he is satisfied has inadvertently omitted to exercise the option provided for by section 18 of the Provident Fund Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 9, within the period prescribed by the said section :
