AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE, 1950.

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Rogers and Howe Limited) (Manufacture and processing of terpeneless essential oils and flavouring essences and concentrates) Order, 1954.

2. Rogers and Howe Limited, a company registered under the Companies Ordinance, is hereby declared to be a pioneer manufacturer, for the purposes of the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance, 1950, in relation to its factory situate at Nos. 26-28, Wrightson Road, Port-of-Spain, and to the manufacture of flavouring Essences and Concentrates (by the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture and processing of terpeneless essential oils, flavouring essences and concentrates) Order, 1950, declared to be a pioneer industry for the purposes of the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance, 1950) with effect from the 1st day of January, 1955, and the production day of the said Company in relation to the products declared to be pioneer products by the said Order is hereby declared to be the 1st day of January, 1955.
