NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED STATISTICS (EMPLOYMENT, WAGES,  
SALARIES AND EARNINGS) REGULATIONS, 1955  
STATISTICS ORDINANCE, CH. 42. No. 11

IN pursuance of section 13 (2) of the Second Schedule of the above-mentioned Ordinance, the Governor in Council hereby notifies the public that it is proposed to make the Statistics (Employment, Wages, Salaries and Earnings) Regulations, 1955, under the said Ordinance.

The purpose of these Regulations is to provide for the collection of information necessary for the appreciation of trends in employment, wages and earnings, and for the preparation of index numbers on average earnings and average wages.

Copies of the draft Regulations may be obtained at the office of the Government Statistician, 2, Edward Street, Port-of-Spain.

Any objection to the draft Regulations made by or on behalf of any person affected must be in writing and state

- (a) the specified grounds of objection, and
- (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked,

and must be addressed to the Clerk of the Executive Council, Governor's Secretariat, St. Ann's, in an envelope clearly marked "Statistics (Employment, Wages, Salaries and Earnings) Regulations" to reach him on or before 25th August, 1955.
