LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE, CH. 27. No. 10

RESOLUTION

OWING to the fact that it is necessary for public purposes to divert a section of the Rampaul Crown Trace, in the Ward of Ortoire, in the County of Victoria :

Be it Resolved :

That in accordance with the provisions of sections 5 and 50 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, Ch. 27. No. 10, the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto be acquired for the public purpose of diverting a section of the Rampaul Crown Trace.

THE SCHEDULE

A parcel of land containing 305 square feet, more or less, situate at Rampaul Crown Trace, in the Ward of Ortoire, in the County of Victoria, forming part of the property belonging now or formerly to Ramlal and Rampaul which is more particularly described and delineated and coloured raw sienna in a plan of survey signed by the Director of Surveys dated 16th November, 1954, executed under Works and Hydraulics Survey Order No. 27 of 1954 and filed in his office.
