SOLICITORS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1956

ARTICLED CLERKS AND SOLICITORS RULES MADE UNDER
THE SOLICITORS ORDINANCE, CH. 7. No 4.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Solicitors (Amendment) Rules, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Solicitors Rules.

2. The following rule is hereby added to the Solicitors Rules immediately after rule 9:

“Power to sit
for examina-
tion in
London

9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in the principal Ordinance or in these rules, any articled clerk otherwise complying with these rules may with the approval of the Society and subject to such terms and conditions as the Society may impose, take his Intermediate Examination in London on the same dates as the examination is held in Port-of-Spain; provided that any additional expense incurred in connection therewith shall be borne by such candidate.”
