THE BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION ORDINANCE, CH. 29. NO. 1

ALLOWANCES PAYABLE TO REGISTRARS OF  
BIRTHS AND DEATHS

(Under section 41 of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, as amended by section 2 of the Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952-1953).

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council under section 41 of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, Ch. 29. No. 1, as amended by the Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952-1953, the Governor in Council hereby approves the scale of allowances payable to Registrars of Births and Deaths set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- (a) For each of the first thirty entries of births and deaths registered in every quarter by a Registrar ... .. \$1.50;
- (b) For each entry of a birth or death registered subsequent to those referred to in paragraph (a) of this Schedule ... .50 cents:  
Provided that the minimum allowance payable to a Registrar of Births and Deaths in respect of any quarter shall be \$45.00.
