DELEGATION OF POWERS AND DUTIES

Public Assistance Ordinance, Ch. 13. No. 1

I exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 18 of the Interpretation Ordinance, Ch. 1. No. 2, I hereby depute the person for the time being holding the office of Minister charged with the administration of Social Services to exercise the powers and perform the duties on behalf of the Governor which the Governor is empowered to exercise and perform by subsection (2) of section 8 of the Public Assistance Ordinance.

Government Notice No. 26 of 1951 as incorporated in the first entry in the schedule to the Delegation of Powers and Duties Order, 1951-1953, is hereby cancelled.

ANIMALS (DISEASES AND IMPORTATION) ORDINANCE, 1954 (No. 19 OF 1954)

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMALS
(DISEASES AND IMPORTATION) ORDINANCE, 1954

THE ANIMALS (IMPORTATION) CONTROL (AMENDMENT No. 2)
REGULATIONS, 1956

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animals (Importation) Control Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1956 and shall be read as one with the Animals (Importation) Control Regulations, 1955, as amended, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. The Seventh Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the words "Great Britain".

3. The Eighth Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting immediately before the word "Canada" the words "Republic of Ireland".
