REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE
PUBLIC ASSISTANCE ACT

THE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE (DISABILITY ASSISTANCE)
(PRESCRIBED FORMS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2004

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Assistance ^{Citation}
(Disability Assistance) (Prescribed Forms) (Amendment) Regulations,
2004.

2. The Form set out in the Schedule to the Public Assistance ^{Legal Notice}
(Disability Assistance) (Prescribed Forms) Regulations, 1997 is ^{No. 186 of}
amended— ¹⁹⁹⁷
^{amended}

(a) in the item entitled “Qualifications”—

(i) in sub-item (a) by deleting the word “forty” and
substituting the word “eighteen”;

(ii) by deleting sub-item (b) and substituting the
following sub-item:

“(b) (i) must be a citizen or resident of
Trinidad and Tobago; and

(ii) must have been continuously resident
in Trinidad and Tobago for a period of
three years preceding the claim for
disability assistance, except that the
period of residence has not been
broken by a period exceeding six
months in the aggregate or must have
been continuously resident in
Trinidad and Tobago for more than
twelve months but less than three
years and has received the approval of
the Minister under section 11A(5) of
the Act;”;

- (b) by deleting item 11 and substituting the following item:
“11. Are you a citizen or resident of Trinidad and Tobago? If you have acquired citizenship by means other than birth, please specify (attach relevant certificates where applicable)”;
- (c) in item 12 by deleting the word “twenty” and substituting the word “three”;
- (d) by deleting sub-item 20(a) and substituting the following sub-item:
“20. (a) Have you ever been employed in Trinidad and Tobago or abroad?”; and
- (e) in the item entitled “*Checklist of attachments*” insert the following sub-item:
“[] Evidence of Citizenship or Residency”.
