RULES

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 17 OF THE PRISONS ACT

THE PRISON (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1991

1. These Rules may be cited as the Prison (Amendment) Rules, 1991. Citation
2. The Prison Rules are amended by inserting immediately after rule 285 the following new rule: Prison Rules amended
Ch. 11. No. 7

“ 285A. Notwithstanding rule 285, where a prisoner is sentenced to a term of imprisonment, whether under one sentence or consecutive sentences the aggregate of which does not exceed twelve months, he may become eligible for discharge when a portion of his term of imprisonment, not exceeding one-half of the whole term of imprisonment, has yet to run, save that nothing in this rule shall authorise the reduction of any period of imprisonment to be served to less than thirty days.”
