ORDER

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE PUBLIC
HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE

THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT TO SCHEDULE)
ORDER, 1980

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment to Schedule) Order, 1980.

2. The Schedule to the Public Holidays Ordinance is amended—

(a) by inserting "Good Friday" between "New Years Day—
or if that day falls on a Sunday, the next following
Monday" and "Easter Monday";

(b) by deleting the words "The day appointed to be kept as
the Sovereign's Birthday" appearing after "The festival
of Corpus Christi";

(c) by inserting "Republic Day—that is the 24th day of
September" and "Christmas Day" between "Independence Day—that is, the 31st day of August" and
"Boxing Day";

(d) by adding immediately after "Boxing Day" the following—

"Eid-ul-Fitr—date to be appointed;
Divali—date to be appointed";

(e) by adding the following new paragraph—

"In this Schedule "date to be appointed" means date to
be appointed by the President by Proclamation.";

(f) by deleting the words "Christmas Day and Good Friday"
occurring in the Note at the end of the Schedule.
