AN ORDINANCE to amend the Resumption of land Ordinance, 1914.

[23rd November, 1917.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Resumption of Short Title. land (Amendment) Ordinance, 1917.

2. Whenever land is resumed under the powers and for the purposes contained in a Crown grant, such resumption shall not confer upon any person any right to compensation in respect of such land; Provided always that compensation shall be payable in respect of:—

No compensa-
tion for land
resumed.

Proviso.

(a.) cultivation on the land actually so resumed; and



(b.) cultivation on land adjacent to such resumed land which is damaged or destroyed by reason of any operations of any Department of the Government or its servants or agents carried on on the land so resumed as aforesaid.

Limitation of
time for
making claims.

3. No claim for compensation under the last preceding section shall be entertained or admitted unless made within twelve months of such claim arising.

Repeal.

4. Section 51 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance (No. 42) is hereby repealed.
