### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 5 of the Public Holidays and Festivals Act, Ch. 19:05 that the President may by Order, declare any day to be a day of Public Festival in Trinidad and Tobago and may specify areas in which and conditions subject to which such public festival may be celebrated:

And whereas it is expedient that the period known as the Carnival in respect of the year 1982 should be so declared:

Now, therefore, I, ELLIS EMMANUEL INNOCENT CLARKE, T.C., President as aforesaid, do hereby order and declare that the period known as the Carnival shall in respect of the year 1982 commence at 4.00 o'clock in the morning of Monday, 22nd February, 1982 and shall end at 12.00 o'clock midnight on Tuesday, 23rd February, 1982.
