

GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 136

REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

EXCHEQUER AND AUDIT ORDINANCE, 1959

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS section 18(1) of the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1959 provides for the establishment of a Contingencies Fund by issues from the Consolidated Fund not exceeding in the aggregate one million, five hundred thousand dollars or such greater sum as the House of Representatives may, by resolution approve, to defray unforeseen expenditure:

And whereas by Resolution passed by the House of Representatives under section 18(1) of the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1959 on the 29th day of May, 1970 the present authorised limit of one million, five hundred thousand dollars was increased to the sum of five million dollars:

And whereas the Minister is satisfied that the present authorised limit of five million dollars which was fixed in the year 1970 is, in 1979 inadequate to defray expenditure and should be increased to the sum of twenty-five million dollars:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Contingencies Fund be increased to twenty-five million dollars.
