AN ORDINANCE to amend the Registration of Deeds Ordinance, No. 57.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Deeds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1913. Short Title.

2. Section 8 of the Registration of Deeds Ordinance, No. 57, is amended by striking out the words "nor shall any deed be registered" in line 19 thereof. Amendment of s. 8 of Ordinance 57.

3. All deeds, the execution whereof took place wholly out of this Colony, which since the first day of May 1905 have been registered under the registration of Deeds Ordinance (No. 57) without the signature of some barrister or certificated conveyancer as having prepared such deed, shall be deemed Registration of certain deeds executed out of the Colony.

to have been properly so registered, and no exception shall be taken to the registration thereof by reason of the absence of such signature.
