AN ORDINANCE to amend the Registration of Deeds
Ordinance, Cap. 174.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Short title.
Deeds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1937, and shall be read as Cap. 174.
one with the Registration of Deeds Ordinance, hereinafter
referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Principal Section 10 (1)
Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after the word of Principal
"any" in the ninth line thereof the following:— Ordinance
amended.

"British Minister or Consul residing in such country
or any."
