2. (1) Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following new subsection to be numbered (3):—

“(3) For the avoidance of doubt it is hereby declared that, notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) hereof, and without prejudice to the provisions of section 18 of this Ordinance, a licensing committee to which an application is made later than the 15th of January in any year shall not thereby be precluded from considering and determining such application.”

(2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall have effect as though enacted at the commencement of the Principal Ordinance.
