AN ORDINANCE to amend the Registrar-General's Ordinance, Cap. 173.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registrar-General's (Amendment) Ordinance, 1935, and shall be construed as one with the Registrar-General's Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Office hours.

2. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

9. The office of the Registrar-General shall be kept open for the transaction of business by the public from the hour of nine thirty o'clock in the forenoon until the hour of four o'clock in the afternoon of every day in the year excepting Saturdays, on which day the office shall be closed at the hour of twelve noon; Provided that the said office shall be kept closed on Sundays, Good Friday, Christmas Day and on all public holidays.
