AN ACT to amend the Registrar General Ordinance,
Ch. 28. No. 1.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by **Enactment**
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Registrar General **short title**
(Amendment) Act, 1974.

2. Section 9 of the Registrar General Ordinance is repealed and replaced as follows:—

“Office
hours

9. The office of the Registrar General shall be kept open for the transaction of business by the public from the hour of eight-thirty o'clock in the forenoon until the hour of four o'clock in the afternoon of every day in the year, except that the said office shall be kept closed on Saturdays, Sundays and on all public holidays.”.
