ORDER

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 9(2) OF THE PRIVILEGES AND  
IMMUNITIES (DIPLOMATIC, CONSULAR AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANI-  
SATIONS) ACT, 1965

THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES (EUROPEAN ECONOMIC  
COMMISSION) ORDER, 1977

1. This Order may be cited as the Privileges and Immunities  
(European Economic Commission) Order, 1977.

2. In this Order—

“the Act” means the Privileges and Immunities (Diplomatic, Act No. 23  
Consular and International Organisations), Act, 1965; of 1965

“the Commission” means the European Economic Commission.

3. The Commission shall be accorded all the privileges and  
immunities set out in Part I of the Fifth Schedule to the Act.

4. The Commission Delegate in Trinidad and Tobago and the  
members of his family only shall be granted the same continuing  
privileges as are granted to the Heads of International Organisations  
in Trinidad and Tobago, that is to say, the customary privileges and  
immunities set out in Part II of the Fifth Schedule to the said Act.

5. The Officers of the Commission who are not nationals of  
Trinidad and Tobago shall be granted only the privileges and immuni-  
ties set out in paragraphs (c) to (g) of section 17 under Article V of  
the Third Schedule to the Act, so however that the provisions of  
Part III of the Fifth Schedule shall not apply on a continuing basis.

6. For the purposes of this Order the privileges and immunities  
referred to in paragraph 1, Part IV of the Fifth Schedule shall not  
apply.
