THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES (CARIBBEAN FINANCIAL
ACTION TASK FORCE) ORDER, 1994

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Privileges and Immunities
(Caribbean Financial Action Task Force) Order, 1994.

Interpretation

2. In this Order "Task Force" means the Caribbean Financial
Action Task Force.

Privileges and
immunities of
Task Force and
Secretariat

3. The Task Force and its Secretariat being a regional agency are
hereby accorded all the privileges and immunities set out in Part I of
the Fifth Schedule to the Act.

Privileges and
immunities of
head of Task
Force
Secretariat and
members of
family

4. The head of the Task Force Secretariat in Trinidad and
Tobago and members of his family together with persons
employed on missions on behalf of the Task Force are hereby
granted the same privileges and immunities as are granted to
the Heads of International Organisations in Trinidad and
Tobago, that is to say, the customary privileges and immunities
set out in Part II and clause 2 of Part IV of the Fifth Schedule
to the Act.

Privileges and
immunities of
other officers
and servants of
Task Force

5. Officers and servants of the Task Force not granted
privileges and immunities under paragraph 4 are hereby granted
the privileges and immunities set out in Part III of the Fifth
Schedule to the Act save that those officers and servants who are
nationals or residents of Trinidad and Tobago are hereby granted
only the privileges and immunities set out in clause 1 of Part III of
that Schedule.

Privileges and
immunities of
representatives
of organs or
members of
committees of
Task Force

6. All persons who are representatives on any organ of the Task
Force or are members of any committee or organ of the Task Force are
hereby granted the privileges and immunities set out in Part II and
clause 1 of Part IV of the Fifth Schedule to the Act.
