BYE-LAWS

MADE BY THE WATER AND SEWERAGE AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 51(1)
OF THE WATER AND SEWERAGE ACT

THE PREVENTION OF WATER POLLUTION (COURLAND
WATER WORKS) BYE-LAWS, 1973

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Prevention of Water Pollution (Courland Water Works) Bye-laws, 1973.

2. No person shall in the areas specified in the Schedule engage in mining, quarrying or any other works which may result in earth, sand, debris or any other waste material entering the Courland River.

3. Every person who contravenes the provision of Bye-law 2 is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding twenty-five dollars and in the case of a continuing offence to a further fine of twenty dollars per day for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

SCHEDULE

The areas referred to in Bye-law 2 are:—

Adventure, Courland and Plymouth from a point commencing 1,000 feet upstream of the bridge on the Plymouth Road which spans the Courland River and enclosed by the contour at 50 feet above Mean Sea Level as shown in the annexed plan.
