MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 29(5) OF THE
REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT

DECLARATION OF EXISTING LIST OF ELECTORS
(PRELIMINARY LIST FOR ELECTORAL REGISTRATION)
ORDER, 1993

WHEREAS subsection (1) of section 29 of the Representation of the People Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") provides *inter alia* that the Elections and Boundaries Commission shall in respect of each electoral district, publish on 1st July of every year a list of all persons qualified to be electors in that electoral district:

And whereas subsection (2) of the said section 29 of the Act provides that the annual list shall continue in force until the 30th June of the following year and on the commencement of the electoral registration shall be deemed to be the preliminary list of electors for that electoral district:

And whereas the annual list of electors published on 1st July, 1992, which was deemed to be the preliminary list for the holding of an electoral registration and which was revised on the basis of that electoral registration and used for the local government elections held on 28th September, 1992, has since been continuously updated:

And whereas subsection (5) of the said section 29 of the Act provides that the President may by Order declare any existing list of electors for an electoral district to be the preliminary list for that electoral district for the purposes of an electoral registration:

Now, therefore, I, NOOR MOHAMED HASSANALI, President as aforesaid do hereby order that the existing list of electors on the records of the Elections and Boundaries Commission as at 14th January, 1993, for the electoral district of Petit Valley/Cocorite in the Region of Diego Martin be deemed to be the preliminary list of electors for the purposes of the electoral registration that commences on 18th January, 1993, in relation to a bye-election in the said electoral district.
