### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 30 of the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01 that for the purposes of an election the President may, by Proclamation published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in the electoral district in which such election is to be held:

Now, therefore, I, JOSEPH EMMANUEL CARTER, Acting President as aforesaid, hereby direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in each of the undermentioned districts as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) Order, 1994, in relation to the electoral area of the Region of San Juan/Laventille for the purpose of the election of a Councillor to serve on the Municipal Council of the Region of San Juan/Laventille and I hereby fix the 3rd day of August, 1995, as the date of the commencement of the said electoral registration.

The electoral districts to which this Proclamation relates are:

1. Aranguez/Warner Village;
2. Barataria;
3. Beetham/Picton;
4. Febeau/Bourg Mulatresse;
5. Maracas Bay/Santa Cruz/La Fillette;
6. Morvant/Upper Malick;
7. Petit Bourg/Champs Fleurs/ Mount Lambert;
8. San Juan East;
9. San Juan West/Caledonia;
10. St. Ann's/Cascade/Mon Repos West;
11. St. Barb's/Chinapoo; and
12. Success/Trou Macaque.
