REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT

DECLARATION OF EXISTING LIST OF ELECTORS
(PRELIMINARY LIST FOR ELECTORAL REGISTRATION)
ORDER, 2000

WHEREAS subsection (1) of section 29 of the Representation of the People Act (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) provides *inter alia* that the Elections and Boundaries Commission shall in respect of each electoral district, publish on 1st July of every year a list (hereinafter referred to as “the annual list”) of all persons qualified to be electors in that electoral district:

And whereas the date for publication of the annual list was varied by the Variation of Specified Date (Annual Parliamentary and Municipal Council Electoral District Lists) Order, 1999, from 1st July, 1999 to 1st November, 1999:

And whereas subsection (2) of the said section 29 of the Act provides that the annual list shall continue in force until the 30th June of the following year and on the commencement of an electoral registration shall be deemed to be the preliminary list of electors for that electoral district:

And whereas the annual list of electors published on 1st November, 1999, has been continuously updated:

And whereas subsection (5) of the said section 29 of the Act provides that the President may by Order declare any existing list of electors for an electoral district to be the preliminary list for that electoral district for the purposes of an electoral registration:

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR N. R. ROBINSON, President as aforesaid, do hereby order that the existing list of electors on the records of the Elections and Boundaries Commission as at 31st January, 2000 for the electoral district of Rio Claro North be deemed to be the preliminary list of electors for the purposes of the electoral registration that commences on 4th February, 2000, in relation to a bye-election in the said electoral district.
