### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 30 of the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01, that for the purposes of an election the President may, by Proclamation, publish in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in the electoral district in which such election is to be held:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE MAXWELL RICHARDS, President as aforesaid, hereby direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in each of the electoral districts defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) (Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2004, in relation to the electoral area of Tobago, for the purpose of the election of members to serve on the Tobago House of Assembly and I hereby fix the 1st day of December, 2004 as the date of the commencement of the said electoral registration.

9. Plymouth/Golden Lane
10. Providence/Mason Hall/Moriah
11. Roxborough/Delaforde
12. Scarborough/Calder Hall
