A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 30 of the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01, that for the purposes of an election the President may, by Proclamation, published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in the electoral district in which such election is to be held:

And whereas it is further provided by the said section, that the President may, by subsequent Proclamation, published in the *Gazette*, fix the date of the termination of an electoral registration:

And whereas by Proclamation dated the 30th day of November, 2004, it was directed that an electoral registration be conducted in each of the electoral districts as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) (Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2004, in relation to the electoral area of Tobago, for the purpose of the election of members to serve on the Tobago House of Assembly and the 1st day of December, 2004 was fixed as the date of the commencement of the said electoral registration:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE MAXWELL RICHARDS, President as aforesaid, do hereby fix the 1st day of April, 2005, as the date of the termination of the electoral registration in each of the undermentioned electoral districts as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) (Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2004.

The electoral districts to which this Proclamation relates are—

1. Bacolet/Mount St. George
2. Belle Garden/Goodwood
3. Bethel/Mt. Irvine
4. Black Rock/Whim/Spring Garden
5. Buccoo/Mt. Pleasant
6. Canaan/Bon Accord
7. Lambeau/Signal Hill
8. Parlatuvier/l'Anse Fourmi/Speyside
9. Plymouth/Golden Lane
10. Providence/Mason Hall/Moriah
11. Roxborough/Delaford
12. Scarborough/Calder Hall
