THE POLICE SERVICE ACT, 1965

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE
POLICE SERVICE ACT, 1965

THE POLICE SERVICE (EXTRA DUTY PAY) REGULATIONS, 1970

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police Service (Extra Duty Citation Pay) Regulations, 1970.

2. Subject to regulation 3, the Commissioner of Police may, in his discretion, at the request in writing of a person who is the organiser of such entertainments, bazaars, private assemblies or other occasions or functions as are approved by the Commissioner, provide for the services of officers in the Second Division of the Police Service for the purpose of preserving order at such entertainments, bazaars, private assemblies, other occasions or functions, and for performing such other duties as the Commissioner may determine, on the payment of the following charges to him in respect of each such officer:—

Inspectors	\$5.00 per hour
Sergeants	\$4.00 per hour
Corporals	\$3.00 per hour
Constables	\$2.00 per hour

3. (1) No Second Division Officer shall be deputed for duty under regulation 2 unless he voluntarily undertakes such duty.

(2) Extra duty may only be performed by officers outside of their official duty hours.

4. (1) Second Division Officers deputed for extra duty under regulation 2 shall be paid for their services at the following rates out of the charges levied under regulation 2 :—

Inspectors	\$3.00 per hour
Sergeants	\$2.50 per hour
Corporals	\$2.00 per hour
Constables	\$1.00 per hour

(2) Any balance in respect of the charges provided for in regulation 2 after disbursing any expenses properly incurred remaining in the hands of the Commissioner of Police shall be paid into the general revenue.

5. Nothing in these Regulations shall apply in the case of a private or public Government function, except that in the case of a private Government function, the Commissioner may, in his discretion levy charges in accordance with regulation 2 and make payments in accordance with regulation 4(1).

Revocation. 6. Regulation 152 of the Police Regulations 1954 and any instruments
G.N. 64-1954 made thereunder are revoked.

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 24 OF THE SPECIAL RESERVE
POLICE ORDINANCE, CH. 11. No. 3, AS AMENDED BY THE SPECIAL RESERVE
POLICE (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1967

THE SPECIAL RESERVE POLICE (EXTRA DUTY PAY)
REGULATIONS, 1970

Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Special Reserve Police (Extra
Duty Pay) Regulations, 1970.

Charges for 2. Subject to regulation 3, the Commissioner of Police may, in his discre-
extra duty tion, at the request in writing of a person who is the organiser of such enter-
prescribed tainments, bazaars, private assemblies or other occasions or functions as are
approved by the Commissioner of Police provide for the services of subordinate
officers of the Special Reserve Police for the purposes of preserving order at
such entertainments, bazaars, private assemblies, other occasions or functions,
and for performing such other duties as the Commissioner may determine, on
the payment of the following charges to him in respect of each such subordi-
nate officer:—

Inspectors	\$2.25 per hour
Sergeants	\$1.75 per hour
Corporals	\$1.50 per hour
Constables	\$1.25 per hour

3. (1) No subordinate officer shall be deputed for duty under regulation 2 unless he voluntarily undertakes such duty. Savings

(2) Extra duty may only be performed by officers outside of their official duty hours.

4. (1) Subordinate officers deputed for extra duty under regulation 2 shall be paid for their services at the following rates paid out of charges levied under regulation 2:— Rates of pay for extra duty prescribed

Inspectors	\$2.00 per hour
Sergeants	\$1.50 per hour
Corporals	\$1.25 per hour
Constables	\$1.00 per hour

(2) Any balance, in respect of the charges provided for in regulation 2 after disbursing any expenses properly incurred, remaining in the hands of the Commissioner of Police shall be paid into the general revenue.

5. Nothing in these Regulations shall apply in the case of a private or public Government function, except that in the case of a private Government function, the Commissioner may, in his discretion levy charges in accordance with regulation 2 and make payments in accordance with regulation 4(1). Charges for Government functions
