PUBLIC BURIAL GROUND

NOTICE is hereby given that His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by the Burial Grounds Ordinance, Ch. 12. No. 18, has with the advice of the Executive Council, set apart and licensed as a Public Burial Ground, the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of a Public Burial Ground.

That parcel of land situate at Nestor, in the Ward of Turure, in the County of Nariva, containing 5a. 2r. 32p. shown coloured pink on the plan signed by the Deputy Director of Surveys dated 12th July, 1954, and filed in his office, bounded as follows:—

North—by lands of Piaree.

South—by a space reserved for a road 30 links wide.

East—by lands of now or formerly Dindial.

West—by lands of G. R. Alston.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE
SLUM CLEARANCE AND HOUSING ORDINANCE, CH. 37. NO. 2

UNDER and by virtue of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 2 of the Slum Clearance and Housing Ordinance, Ch. 37. No. 2, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the County Councils (Local Authorities) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of December, 1954.

2. County Councils established under the provisions of the County Councils Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 15, are hereby declared, for the purposes of the Slum Clearance and Housing Ordinance, Ch. 37. No. 2, to be Local Authorities for the areas comprising their respective electoral districts.
