MADE BY THE PRESIDENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 90(2) OF THE  
MERCHANT SHIPPING ORDINANCE

THE MERCHANT SHIPPING (EXAMINATIONS FOR CERTIFI-  
CATES OF COMPETENCY) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1983.

Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Examina-  
tions for Certificates of Competency) (Amendment) Rules, 1983.

2. Rule 2 of the Merchant Shipping (Examinations for Certificates  
of Competency) Rules is repealed and the following substituted  
therefor—

“ 2. (1) A person is not eligible for membership on the  
Board of Examiners to be appointed for the purposes of the  
Merchant Shipping Ordinance, unless—

- (a) he has attained the rank of Lieutenant Com-  
mander in the Defence Force (Coast Guard) of  
Trinidad and Tobago; or
- (b) he has attained the rank of Lieutenant in the  
Royal Navy or in the navy of any other  
Commonwealth country; or
- (c) he holds a Master Mariners Foreign Going Certi-  
ficate of Competency issued by the Board of  
Trade or the equivalent Certificate issued by  
or on behalf of a Government of a Common-  
wealth country; or
- (d) he holds a Home Trade Certificate as Master  
issued by or on behalf of the Government of  
Trinidad and Tobago, or the equivalent Certifi-  
cate issued by or on behalf of the Government  
of Jamaica or any other country or countries  
as may be determined by the Minister from  
time to time; or
- (e) he holds a Certificate of Competency as First  
Class Engineer issued by the Board of Trade or  
the equivalent Certificate issued by or on  
behalf of a Government of a Commonwealth  
country; or

- (f) he holds a Home Trade Certificate of Competency as First Class Engineer issued by or on behalf of the Government of Trinidad and Tobago, or the equivalent Certificate issued by or on behalf of the Government of Jamaica or any other country or countries as may be determined by the Minister from time to time.

(2) For examinations for a Home Trade Certificate of Competency as First Class Engineer, at least two examiners shall hold the qualification set out in paragraph (e) of sub-rule (1), and for examinations for Certificates of Competency as Second Class Engineer, at least one examiner shall hold the qualification set out in paragraph (f) of the said sub-rule.”.
