RESOLUTION

CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, CH. 32, No. 2

RESOLVED : That this Council, in accordance with the provisions of section 49A of the Customs Ordinance as enacted by the Customs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951-1953, approves the exemption from the payment of import duties of customs on the classes of goods specified in the second column of the Appendix hereto imported for the purpose specified in the third column of the said Appendix during the period terminating not later than the date prescribed in the fourth column of the said Appendix as the last date on which such exemption shall be granted.

THE TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES ORDINANCE, CH. 9, No. 12

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER THE TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES ORDINANCE

THE TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1957

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Travelling Allowances (Amendment) Regulations, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Travelling Allowances Regulations, 1953, as amended, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 35 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended—

(a) by substituting a colon for the full stop occurring at the end thereof; and

(b) by adding immediately thereafter the following proviso :—

“Provided that the maximum period for which the Financial Secretary may authorise the payment of the whole or part of any such allowance shall not in any case exceed two months.”
